



William Q. Judge, Ph.D.

William Q. Judge is the E.V. Williams Professor of Strategic Leadership at Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Virginia. Over the past several decades, he has provided consulting services with a wide variety of firms in many different industries; and has taught executives in ten different countries.

His consulting expertise is centered on enhancing (1) leadership and organizational development, (2) strategy formation and execution that meets strategic objectives, and (3) board or director and top management team effectiveness. He has worked primarily with C-suite executives as well as corporate directors in his consulting practice.

Bill received his MBA and Ph.D. degrees from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Prior to his graduate work, he worked in the strategic planning department of a Fortune 200 firm. In the 1990s, he served on the Board of Trustees for a \$250 million health system. Bill served as a U.S. Fulbright Scholar at MGIMO University in Russia in 2001; and was a distinguished visiting scholar at the top-ranked IE Business School in Madrid, Spain in 2013. He currently is serving as the founding President of the International Corporate Governance Society. He has earned teaching awards on six different occasions during his career, and co-authored "Change Management: Power and Influence" - one of the most popular teaching simulations at Harvard Business Publishing.
